## End-of-Year Documentation

Before summer, document:

- Current performance levels for all goals
- Effective strategies and reinforcers
- Known triggers and warning signs
- Successful de-escalation approaches
- Communication preferences
- Progress graphs and trend data

## Parent Summer Support Plan

Information to share with families:

- Copy of behavior goals in parent-friendly language
- Strategies to continue at home
- What reinforcement has worked at school
- Signs of progress to watch for
- When to be concerned
- Contact info for summer questions

## Summer Carryover Strategies

**For Parents**

- Maintain consistent routines as much as possible
- Use visual schedules for summer activities
- Continue reinforcement for target behaviors
- Practice replacement behaviors in community settings
- Provide social opportunities

**For Summer Programs**

- Share transition summary with summer staff
- Provide training on key strategies
- Ensure reinforcement system can continue
- Establish communication with school

## Fall Transition Planning

Before school starts:

- Review end-of-year documentation
- Contact family about summer observations
- Plan gradual re-entry if needed
- Prepare environment and materials
- Schedule early team meeting
